## About

The Brussels marathon attracts 12,000 runners each year. Since 2012, over 2,300 participants have participated in the "Running for Missing Children Europe" running team for the Brussels marathon and Antwerp 10 Miles.

Missing Children Europe welcomes your organisation to join our team at the Brussels marathon for the 2018 edition. The aim of this event is to raise awareness and funds for Missing Children Europe's projects to prevent, protect and support missing children.

Various race courses are available, allowing participants of all ages and experience levels to pick a suitable distance. The distances offered include 5 km, 21km and 42 km.

Participants will raise awareness of Missing Children Europe and their organisation by wearing a "Running for Missing Children Europe" T-shirt with the logo of their company on the back.
